## Student Legal Services Undergraduate Legal Research Internship Information Sheet

<u>Overview of the position:</u> This is an unpaid internship in UC San Diego Student Legal Services (SLS) that will provide 2-3 undergraduate students with an opportunity to get an inside look into the legal profession.

<u>Tasks:</u> Contribute to the Student Legal Services Blog. Conduct legal research under the supervision of an attorney. Develop projects to raise campus awareness about legal issues facing students. Support marketing and outreach efforts as needed.

<u>Time commitment:</u> Interns are expected to volunteer at least four hours per week. Interns are also required to complete the Discover the Law program during Winter Quarter 2019 and attend one staff meeting per quarter. The internship begins September 2019 and will end March 2020. Interns will have the option of continuing in the internship through May 2020.

<u>Qualifications</u>: To be eligible, applicants must be currently registered at UC San Diego with a class standing of junior or higher as of Fall 2019 and have an interest in the legal profession.
