

COVID-19 STUDENT CONDUCT AMNESTY PROGRAM
FINAL 10-16-20

Amnesty for COVID 19 related student conduct incidents may be extended to Students under the following circumstances:

- Communicating in good faith during the contact tracing process when it is clear the Student was not aware they were contagious with COVID-19 when gathering with other members of the campus community. UC San Diego will generally not initiate the student conduct process under these circumstances.

Exceptions to this program include either or both of the following scenarios:

- When the Student was aware of their positive COVID-19 test, and/or knowingly infected or intended to infect another member of the campus community.
- Other major Standards of Conduct violations were committed by the Student during the same incident (e.g. distribution of controlled substances, hazing, assault/battery, vandalism, etc.).

Students participating as a complainant or witness in an investigation under the *Sexual Violence and Sexual Harassment (SVSH) Policy* will not be subject to the student conduct process for COVID-19 related violations at or near the time of the incident. This also applies to Students participating in an Alternative Resolution process under the *SVSH Policy*.
